



Mantainance for Copper

Generell Information

Thank you for purchasing a Saveri product, as you love the characteristic of the material, as it is. In order to maintain the beauty of the item, we ask you to pay close attention to the following advices and our product will bring you joy for a long time.

Our Mesh Collection combines the fashionable copper with concrete. The collection is suitable for indoor and outdoor use, but not frost poof.

Material

Steel is one of the most used materials worldwide. Copper plated steel is elegant, brings glamour and has an urban touch.

Production

All Saveri products are exclusively designed in-house. Our design Team works with technician and craftsmen and created the Mesh Collection with a great precision and diligence

A copper layer is applied to the steel and an additional layer of topcoat protects the steel again corrosion.

It is a very thin coat and comparable with car lacquer, which is used for thin materials. The coat is applied in lavishly process of several steps.

Features

Copper plated steel can show verdigris, which is characteristic, but can be removed.

The interior of the steel tube remains uncoated (due to technical reasons) however the plastic caps / glides on the base of the furniture provide a sealed environment to protect the steel from corrosion and penetration from water / other corrosive substances

Be sure not to damage the outer protective clear lacquer topcoat as this may lead to corrosion of the steel frame

Take Care

Crucial for long-lasting beauty of the surface is the proper handling and regular maintenance. Please follow the following care directions.

- Purchase and use a chamois cloth to regularly wipe over the copper plated steel frame
- ONLY use non-abrasive soft liquid detergent do not use any type of cleaning agent that will cause abrasion to the lacquer topcoat
- Rinse furniture thoroughly with clean water and wipe over frame with the chamois leather cloth and allow to dry naturally
- Do not use any form of oil based cleaner or sealers
- Do not place the furniture in wet areas or in any water pool
- During Winter (and during periods of no use), store the furniture in dry protected environments
- On a regular basis check the copper plated steel frame for scratches or damage to the plating (plan on doing this as part of your regular cleaning and maintenance)
- To remove verdigris, apply distilled vinegar to a clean soft cloth and gently buff the metal surface. The vinegar should remove most (if not all) the verdigris spots.

Scratches on the surface - damage on the topcoat

In daily use, it is possible that the coat get scratches and the protective coat is damaged.

- Cover the scratched area with a clear out door coat varnish pen. As sooner you act, as less damage can appear from corrosion.
- Verdigris is a characteristic of copper, but rarely appear on coated copper. You can remove the verdigris with common verdigris remover or use vinegar.
